For those who don't already know Bebe's story, she is an avid fencer who contracted a rare and deadly strain of meningitis at 11 years old, which forced doctors to amputate her arms and legs to save her life.

Bebe's story is one of strength, optimism, and grit as she defied all odds and continued to pursue her passion for fencing, winning various medals including the Paralympic gold medal in 2016!

Bebe is passionate about increasing awareness of the Olympic sport and she founded Art4sport together with her parents, which support children who undergo amputation, using sport for therapy.

During the Greatness Lecture, Bebe shared with us what motivates her, her aspirations for the future, and her desire to help implement the changes she would like to see in Paralympic sports.
