

Tagor to start the construction of second stage of Adora Urban Village

Tagor, the developer of residential complex Adora Urban Village in the Bragadiru area of south western Bucharest, announced it would start the second stage of the project

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Currently, the company is pending construction permits for the construction of two blocks of 94 apartments, 25 per cent more compared to the first development stage of the project. According to Andreea Hamza, marketing and sales director at Tagor, the minimum area of an apartment in Adora will have 42 sqm, functioning as small apartments with two rooms. The Adora projects are

owned by British fund Patron Capital and managed by Tagor asset management company. The projects started in 2013 with Adora Urban Village and continued in 2014 and 2015 with Adora Park in Arad, Adora Forest in Timisoara and Adora Pipera in northern Bucharest.

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
